Hope you are cognizant of the latest decision of CBSE to replace the continuous and comprehensive evaluation (CCE) scheme by uniform system of assessment and examination for grades (VI-IX) and restoration of board examination for grade X from the academic year 2017-18.

In the remodeled assessment structure, the final examination for grade X will be conducted by the board for 80 marks in each subject covering 100% syllabus at the end of the academic year. In order to enhance subject specific learning and understanding, the students will be internally assessed for 20 marks by the school which will include periodic tests, assignment completion and subject enrichment activities

We have adapted the same pattern for grades VI-IX. Initially the students will take little time to get adjusted to the new pattern wherein, the whole academic year syllabus will be evaluated in the final examination. With the consistent efforts and perseverance from the



teaching staff and your incessant support we will be able to guide our students in the continuous and effective learning process. The gradually increasing portion of contents would prepare the students mentally and physically to face the secondary and senior secondary board examination with confidence and thus ensure that the quality of education is enhanced.

#### GRADE X AND XII- RESULT AT A GLANCE




